

LAWRENCE GOLDMAN has an M.A. from the University of Oxford and an M.A. and Ph.D. from University of Cambridge. He was a Fellow and Tutor in History at St. Peter's College, Oxford, for 29 years and for a decade he was Editor of the Oxford Dictionary of National Biography.

Professor Goldman's publications include *Dons and Workers: Oxford and Adult Education Since 1850* (OUP, 1995), *Science, Reform and Politics in Victorian Britain: The Social Science Association 1857-1886* (CUP, 2002) and *The Life of R. H. Tawney. Socialism and History* (2013). He edited the collection *The Blind Victorian: Henry Fawcett and British Liberalism* (CUP, 1989) and has published articles in journals including the *English Historical Review, Past and Present*, and *The Historical Journal*. Most recently he was Director of the Institute of Historical Research. He is a Fellow of the Royal Historical Society.
